An Eight-Day Sample Itinerary

Muscat → Nizwa → Jabal Akhdar → Sugar Dunes → Sur → Muscat

APPROXIMATE BUDGET Around ₹30,000 per person, excluding flights	BEST TIME TO VISIT October to March, December to February is most pleasant
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A first look at how a week in Oman comes together, from Muscat's mosques and Souqs to the green heights of Jabal Akhdar and the dunes along the coast. Every Just Go trip is shaped around a vetted local expert and adjusted to your pace; this is simply a starting point.

DAY	BASE	THEME	SAMPLE PLAN
1	Muscat	Arrival in Muscat	Arrive in the morning; visit the Sultan Qaboos Grand Mosque, then spend the day exploring Muscat's Souqs and old-town attractions.
2	Muscat	Muscat and the Coast	Continue exploring Muscat and its neighboring towns: the pastel-hued 'Santorini' district, the corniche pier, and Mutrah Souq.
3	Nizwa	Nizwa at Dawn	Depart around 4 AM to reach Nizwa's goat souq 30 minutes before sunrise (Fridays only); spend the rest of the morning in the local souq and at the Oman Across Ages Museum; overnight in Nizwa.
4	Jabal Akhdar	Up the Green Mountain	Only 4x4s are allowed past the checkpoint, so rent one or arrange a hotel transfer from the checkpoint parking (book both ahead). Watch the sunset over the hills and unwind.
5	Sugar Dunes	Into the Desert Coast	Depart after lunch for Sugar Dunes Beach Resort, arrive in time for dinner; settle in and rest.
6	Sugar Dunes	Dunes and Downtime	A day for desert sports and camping for the adventurous or simply resting at the resort.
7	Muscat (via Sur)	The Coastal Route	Take the coastal road back toward Muscat, stopping in Sur along the way.
8	Departure	Back to Muscat	Reach Muscat and depart in the evening.
