A Seven-Day Sample Itinerary

Jaipur → Pushkar → Jodhpur → Jaisalmer

APPROXIMATE BUDGET Around ₹15,000 per person, excluding flights	BEST TIME TO VISIT November to February
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A first look at how a week in Rajasthan comes together, from the Pink City to the dunes outside Jaisalmer. Every Just Go trip is shaped around a vetted local expert and adjusted to your pace; this is simply a starting point.

DAY	BASE	THEME	SAMPLE PLAN
1	Jaipur	Welcome to the Pink City	Arrive in the morning; settle in, then wander the Old City lanes and markets as evening falls.
2	Jaipur	Amber Fort	A morning at Amber Fort and the hilltop forts above the city; afternoon free for the City Palace or Hawa Mahal.
3	Pushkar	Lakeside and Low-Key	Drive to Pushkar (about 3.5 hours); rest by the lake, then a sunset stroll through the market.
4	Jodhpur	Into the Blue City	Drive to Jodhpur (about 4.5 hours), arriving by noon; explore the blue lanes and Sardar Market by evening.
5	Jodhpur	Mehrangarh Fort	A full morning at Mehrangarh Fort, then dinner at one of the rooftop restaurants with the fort lit up above.
6	Jaisalmer	Into the Thar Desert	Drive to Jaisalmer (about 5.5 hours); explore the fort by late afternoon, then a night in the desert with a safari.
7	Jaisalmer	Jaisalmer, Unhurried	Bada Bagh on the way back from the camp, a relaxed walk around Gadisar Lake, and an afternoon exploring the fort's havelis and lanes at a slower pace, ending with sunset from the ramparts.
7	Departure	Send-Off	A slow morning in the town before departure.
